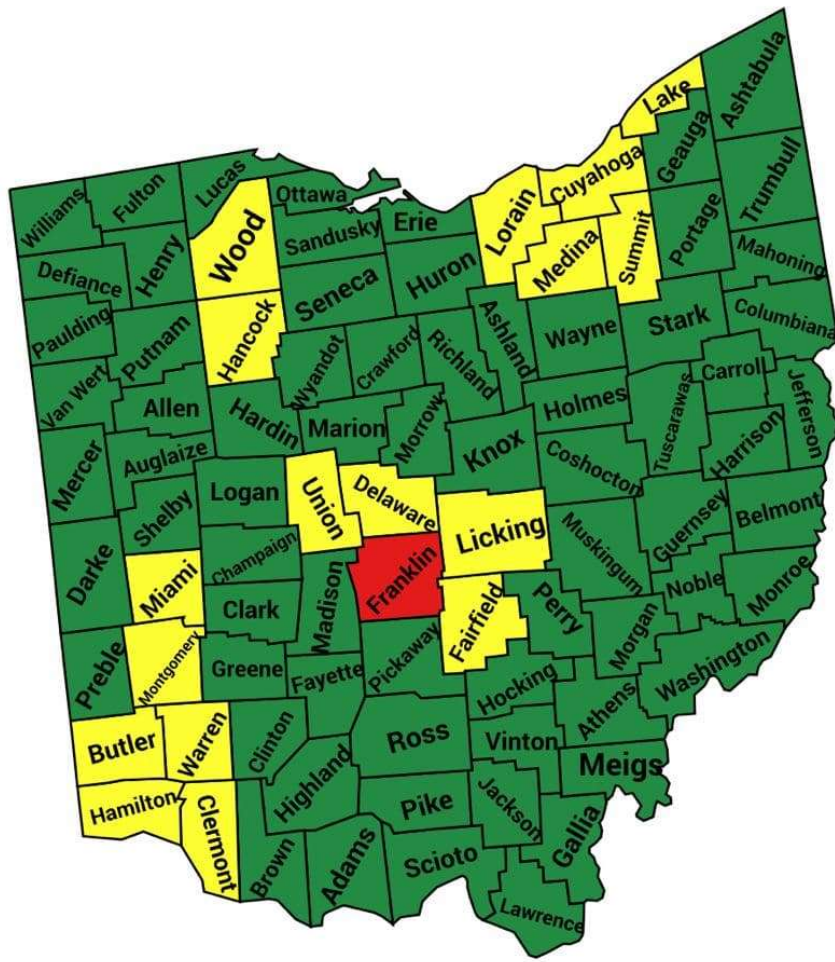

Ohio Election Analysis by Seth Keshel

Former US military intelligence officer and statistical analyst Seth Keshel analyzed the trends of voter registrations versus actual votes. The following report indicates which counties' vote counts align with the trend in voter registrations and which have small or large divergences. Each county is flagged as red, yellow, or green, based on whether the 2020 vote totals aligned with the expected trends (as past decades demonstrate they typically do), or if they diverged in statistically unlikely ways.



Likely Clean
Aligns with voter registration trends, as expected



Suspect, Likely Fraud
Moderate divergence from trend



Strong/Rampant Fraud
Strong, unexplainable divergence from trend

Ohio was a blowout in 2016, higher than most predicted, with the margin slightly lighter this year, but with more votes won by. This state, regionally, is clean, compared to the cesspools that are MI and PA. I estimate Biden to be 88k higher than trends, population growth, previous records, and population growth would suggest.

Most curiously (sarcasm), Cuyahoga County (Cleveland) didn't appear to have nearly the level of interest in candidate Biden as Wayne County ([Michigan](#)) and nearby Allegheny County ([Pennsylvania](#)) did. Biden gained just 18k votes, but with declining voter roll and a solid Trump gain, I still flagged 8k as class yellow.

Franklin is the only red, 15k excess, 19% over Obama '08 new vote growth with solid Trump gain opposing.

If Biden is 88k heavy, Trump's margin would have been 9.7% (54.0-44.3), a win of 564k votes.

Best targets for audits: Butler, Delaware, Licking, Lake, Union, Warren

Seth has listed Ohio's Franklin County as being among the [Nation's Top 100 Worst Counties](#) in terms of abnormal trends during the 2020 election.

Methodology

Seth Keshel's estimates are based on the percentage of voters who are registered to each party (where it's possible to obtain this information) compared to the actual votes for each party. He examined these party trends over the last two decades, as well as population growth, which brought to light the strange and statistically unlikely outliers and anomalies that occurred in 2020.
