Below and attached is in response to the following section of your letter dated January 29, 2023:

The twenty-three page report also states that, "Ohio had election integrity issues long before 2020." The report states the data provided on page 22 is from the November 2008 Presidential General Election. However upon review of the numbers provided, the data supplied in the report does not match the official election record. The incorrect data supplied in the report is below, on the right, with the correct data on the left. We cannot verify the source of the report's incorrect data.

Please advise the source of your "Data from Official Record" that does not match the Official Results posted by Ohio Secretary of State.

Why don't the results of both Official Results/Official Record match?

Since the data provided from the Secretary of State's Official Results do not match your Official Record, whose data is actually OFFICIAL?

Correct me if I am wrong, but It is my understanding each county provides voting results to the Secretary of State, and the Secretary of State is in control of the Official Results.

When there is a discrepancy in Official Results/Official Records as in this case, whose results are used to determine the outcome of an election?

The Secretary of State Official Results reported 102 precincts in Ohio with over 100% Voter Turnout in the November 2008 election, which was over SIXTY THOUSAND (60,133) MORE BALLOTS COUNTED in these precincts THAN WERE REGISTERED VOTERS.

While we may never know how this situation affected the results of elections in the November 2008 election, the sheer number of potential illegitimate votes indicates it could be a very real possibility.

It is situations like this that cause citizens in Butler County and across all of Ohio to be very concerned about Election Integrity in our counties and state. Your thorough investigation and response to each item in the red font above is requested and very much appreciated.

It is our sincere hope that Butler County Board of Elections will continue to assist the efforts of volunteer citizens concerned with Election Integrity in Butler County and Ohio so situations similar to 2008 in which over 60,000 more votes were counted than were registered voters NEVER EVER HAPPENS AGAIN IN FUTURE OHIO ELECTIONS.

OHIO HAD ELECTION INTEGRITY ISSUES LONG BEFORE 2020

During the 2008 presidential election, **102 precincts in Ohio had over 100% voter turnout, including 2 precincts in Butler County.** There were over sixty thousand (60,133) more ballots counted in these precincts than were registered voters. This is **NOT** legal and very likely altered the results of many Ohio election races. The election results in these precincts **NEVER** should have been certified; yet the results were signed off by 102 precincts, including 2 in Butler County, followed by **11** counties, including Butler County, and finally by Ohio Secretary of State Jennifer Brunner. Keep in mind, Ballot Stuffing is obvious in these precincts where ballots exceed registered voters; imagine all the other precincts that may have Ballot Stuffing as well, but stay under the radar as their overall ballots cast do not exceed registered voters. This explains why it is so important to have accurate voter registration rolls.
